Duties include loading and unloading ride units and checking rider seatbelts and lapbars, operating ride control panels and monitoring ride for proper operation. Ride operators also interact closely with park guests by communicating ride safety rules, checking for criteria such as proper height, and answering guest questions and concerns Food & Beverage Ambassadors: As a food service ambassador you'll experience working in multiple restaurants throughout the summer. Food service ambassadors are responsible for preparing, cooking, and presenting food to our guests in a timely and efficient manner while maintaining the highest levels of safety standards Lifeguard Ambassadors: Ensure safe, smooth, efficient operation of assigned rides. Ability to complete swimming training and meet the standards of the Lifeguard Training Program, including First Aid & CPR, Swim Rescue, and Spinal Injury Management. You must always be attentive and focused while on duty. You will be required to maintain order in the rides and pool areas, rescue swimmers in danger and administer first aid if required
